Recognizing outstanding service to children with learning disabilities

Nominations are now open for the annual POWER TO ACHIEVE award. This annual award and gift recognizes and encourages those individuals who have made remarkable voluntary contributions towards the advancement of education, social development, legal rights, health and/or general well-being of children with learning disabilities.

The award will be presented to the winning recipient during the *Speaking of Kids* Conference scheduled for October 22, 2010. Honorable mentions will also be given a recognition certificate.

Who is Eligible?

Any resident of the Metro Vancouver, BC area who is over the age of 19 that has made a significant contribution to enhancing and/or improving the life of a child with learning disabilities.

Selection Criteria

Nomination forms are accepted by the Learning Disabilities Association- Vancouver up to August 31, 2010. In two pages or less, the nomination should highlight the nominees' accomplishments and outline why s/he should be singled out for recognition; how did s/he visibly impact the lives of children with learning disabilities; how did s/he demonstrate or accomplish this.

All nominations will be reviewed and the winner will be contacted by September 30, 2010.

Please note: Any nomination that does not meet the outlined criteria will be disqualified.
